## **New Data Discussion**

Data from the screening questions and the Imes parent interview were shared with the group. Overall, the data supported the need for GSFN providers to continue to come together and be a point of contact to connect community members with needed resources. The following additional insights were noted:

- A trend for training needs for teens and parents (e.g. special needs, pregnancy prevention, GED)
- Look to GSFN members to provide trainings (TOPS, DDD)
- Mental health services and access to health care and medical homes as community gaps

Based on the data, the group identified member gaps in the areas of immigration as well as members who need to be reengaged from the Glendale Police Department and medical centers (e.g. MIHS).
