Barrier Busters:

Non-Certified Relative Provider (NCRP) Requirements

DEFINITION: Non-Certified Relative Provider means a person who is at least eighteen years of age, who provides child care services to an eligible child, who is by blood or marriage or by court decree the grandparent, great-grandparent, sibling not residing in the same household, aunt, great-aunt, uncle or great-uncle of the eligible child and who meets the department's requirements to be a noncertified relative provider.

Eligible families receiving Child Care Assistance can choose to receive child care services from several categories of child care providers including a Non-Certified Relative Provider (NCRP). Eligible families interested in selecting a family member as their child care provider must contact their child care specialist.

An NCRP must be able to check all boxes below. An NCRP must:

- Be at least 18 years of age;
- Be legally eligible to work in the United States;
(Complete Contractor Eligibility Verification form and provide required documentation.)
- Be one of the following to the DES eligible child by blood, marriage, or court decree:

✓ Aunt	✓ Uncle	✓ Great-Aunt	✓ Great-Uncle
✓ Grandparent	✓ Great-Grandparent	✓ Adult sibling who does not live in the same household.	

If you are related to the eligible child in any other way, you are NOT eligible to become an NCRP.
- Obtain a Level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card from the Arizona Department of Public Safety;
- Pass a Department of Child Safety background check;
- Participate in the NCRP Onboarding and complete and submit an NCRP Application Packet to the Certification Specialist;
- Review, agree, and abide by all terms in the NCRP Child Care Provider Registration Agreement;
- Accept the NCRP reimbursements rates listed on the *Maximum Reimbursement Rates for Child Care (CCA-1227A)* form minus the family required co-payment;
- Keep records of the child care provided for a minimum of five years;
- Understand that monies received in payment for childcare services may be taxable income and may affect benefits such as Nutrition Assistance, Social Security, etc.;
- Not be a member of the eligible family's TANF Cash Assistance unit;
- Understand that all child care must be provided in the state of Arizona at the specified location on the NCRP Child Care Provider Registration Agreement; and
- Understand there is the option to become a DES Certified Family Child Care Provider.

- Over the next 6 months, DCC will be working on a FFY 2025-2027 CCDF State Plan. As we work through the State Plan, we will be seeking input from our Arizona Tribes and our stakeholders.
